Lahore, July 24: Ameer Jamaat-e-Islami, Qazi Hussain Ahmed has warned the government that unrest in the country would assume serious dimensions if it assisted the United States or any agency in arrest of Osama bin Laden.

"Already the government has created trouble for itself by agreeing to Washington accord, and this development would sound death knell for it," Qazi said while addressing a high level party meeting here at the JI headquarters Mansoorah.

If government facilitates any agency anti-Osama operation, it will not be in national interest, he said. The meeting expressed concern over the reports that three U.S warships had entered Pakistan's territorial waters near the Gawadar coast.

The JI ameer apprised the meeting that reliable reports suggested the U.S ships had arrived for 'interference' in Afghanistan. He quoted a Pakistan-based Taliban government official as having said so.

He regretted that the past record of the government in this particular context was not too good. "We know that the Nawaz has previously allowed the US administration to interfere, violating the territorial integrity of the two countries," Qazi said.

The meeting urged the Pakistan government and the US administration to desist from any such action. The JI ameer has also called upon all and sundry to, especially the Lahoriites to participate in the Kargil-Kashmir Million march on Sunday.
